ers have the mechanism integrated directly into the handle, re-

sulting in an ultra-compact tool. With 36 teeth, the tools allow an

extremely low return angle of only 10°.

Hold on – there's more! Allow me to call to your attention two fur-

ther advantages: Intuitive ratcheting and spinning the tool in the

screwdriving direction is now possible thanks to the slip-proof di-

rection switch. It rocks when positioning the tool and speeds up

work with smooth-running screws. The ratchet screwdriver can be

switched to the right and left, and also has a position at 0°. Once set

at this position, the tool can be used as a regular screwdriver. This

is especially important when you want to work with great preci-

sion.
